



Coronavirus:

Returning to the Workplace after Recovering from a Positive COVID-19 Test

27 MARCH 2020

Current advice from the Public Health Unit indicates that:

- The current exclusion period for an individual who has tested positive to COVID-19 depends on the severity of the infection.
- Employees can only return to the workplace where they have:
 - returned two (2) negative specimens (swabs) collected greater than 24 hours apart; and
 - received a letter from the Public Health Unit (PHU) clearing them from isolation and confirming that they have tested negative for COVID-19.

A copy of the written advice from PHU is to be provided to an employee's Principal/Manager prior to that employee resuming duty.
